Please note that entries received after 2nd May will only be considered if there is space available and you pay in full at the time of application. Only entries received and paid for before the 2nd May will get a FREE listing in the Show Guide.

PLEASE REMEMBER WHEN BOOKING A MARQUEE PITCH

- Boundaries cannot be moved on Show days so as not to disadvantage neighbouring traders.
- Sub-letting of your pitch or any part of it is not allowed.
- Sites are available within this marquee for Exhibitors to display floral or foliage exhibits
 which will be judged by not fewer than two recognised judges and certificates, together with
 cash prizes, will be awarded to those exhibits which, in the opinion of the judges, are of
 sufficient merit to qualify for such an award.
- The pitches along the side of the marquee have a storage area behind a 7ft high back rail at the rear of the exhibition space inside the wall of the marquee.

HOW DO I PAY?

By BACS (preferred) to Axe Vale Festival Ltd. Sort Code 30 90 37 A/C 35115660 Or by cheque payable to Axe Vale Festival Ltd Payment in full is required with your Application Form.

Please use your Company name as a reference so that we can allocate payments correctly. Applications will not be processed until full payment has been made.

AND ONCE I'VE PAID?

- We'll send you a receipted Application Form and confirmation of booking (by email or post).
- Final details will be sent to you in June.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I WANT TO CANCEL?

- If an Exhibitor withdraws from the Show or fails to attend then no refunds will be given.
- Should the Show be cancelled for any reason beyond our control prior to being opened to
 the public, each Exhibitor will be entitled to a refund of all sums paid for that year up to the
 date of cancellation, less £20 for administration costs. Alternatively they may choose to put
 the money towards a stand at next year's Show. Please note that ticket purchases are non
 refundable.
- Please note that we are not liable for any costs incurred by Exhibitors. No Exhibitor shall have any further claim for loss, damage, interest or compensation.

CAN I HAVE ELECTRICITY?

- Yes of course if you complete the relevant part on The Application Form
- Please note that the 5amp electricity choice will not be sufficient for a kettle.
- It is essential that you ensure any equipment is in safe working order and has been suitably tested.
- All equipment must be declared on the Electrical Supply Form.
- Compliance with the Fire Safety Order 2005 is essential. Very good guidance on food concession Trade Stands can be found on the National Fire Chiefs Council website: www.cfoa.org.uk, under event safety documentation.
- Please note that electricity is only available during opening hours of the Show, unless previously arranged.
- THE USE OF PRIVATE GENERATORS IS NOT PERMITTED.

HOW ARE PITCHES ALLOCATED?

We lay out the Showground to optimise footfall for our Exhibitors, wherever possible
meeting any special requests made on the Application Forms. We work on a first come, first
served basis and entirely at the discretion of the Organisers but will do our best to please
you. Please understand that it just isn't possible to give everyone exactly what they want –
but we do try hard!

CANICAMP?

- Absolutely! You can bring a caravan, motor home or tent. There will be an area set aside in Car Park B with a WC and water supply provided.
- Alternatively a list of accommodation is available from the Visitor Information Point at Axminster Heritage Centre, Thomas Whitty House on 01297 34386.
- Please note that for Safety, Security and Insurance purposes NO OVERNIGHT SLEEPING OR CAMPING IS PERMITTED ON THE SHOWGROUND ITSELF.
- Please note that dogs are used to patrol the Showground overnight.
